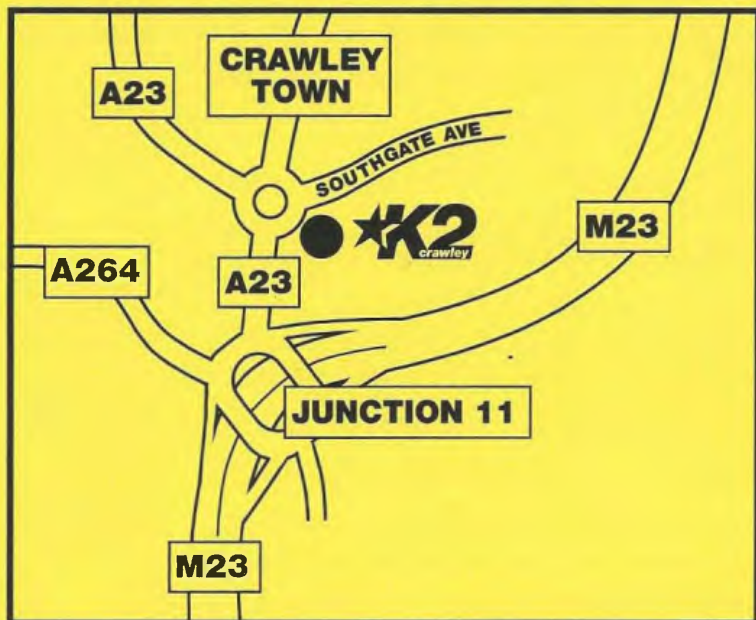

How to find **LGW2019**



By Car

The quickest way there, which avoids Crawley Town Centre, is to leave the M23 at Junction 11. At the roundabout take the exit (Pease Pottage Hill) signposted A23 to Crawley. At the first set of traffic lights turn right into K2 Crawley. Caution - the car park fills up very quickly. Look out for signs directing visitors to the alternative car parking at the Football Stadium and elsewhere.

By public bus

Metrobus FASTWAY Routes 10 and 20 operate from Gatwick Airport to Southgate Avenue South which is five minutes walk from K2 Crawley. Metrobus Route 2 operates from Crawley Bus Station to the K2 Crawley. Metrobus information 01293-449191.

FREE BUS From Gatwick Airport South Terminal Coach Station
